Portfolio Entries

When you teach students to create a portfolio no matter how old or at what age it is important that they are taught correctly from the beginning. There isn't an actual correct way. Rather what you are trying to do is assist the student to develop a habit of responsibility and self-discipline.

If the work of each student is correctly logged at the time of execution there is no stress and bother come assessment time.

If the student develops this habit there will be no stress or bother when they use the portfolio to

- Gain access to a course such as TAFE.
- Gain entry to a club such as the local Photography Club
- Apply for a job such as graphic artist or in a gallery or museum
- Present artworks in a space like Deviant Art

The process of compiling work in a gallery will also do wonders for student self esteem and make sharing with family and friends easier.

If the students get used to compiling a main gallery of their work they will only need to cut and paste information from this main portal whenever they want to upload work in other places.
